16 17	All expenditures of \$50,000 or more shall be formally advertised under City Charter Article VI, \S 11(c).
18	(C) BOARD APPROVAL.
19 20	All expenditures of \$25,000 or more shall be subject to Board of Estimates approval under City Charter Article VI, \S 11(f).
