


"You've got coal dust all along the outside window sills and even on the inside of your window, where it comes through the screens. It's nasty."




"The coal dust covers everything. Even your windshields. It's nasty, it gets all over you."









"We were walking down **Curtis Ave and we saw** about 5 explosions happen and we are now seeing busted windows. I would like to see better air quality and an explanation about what happened."







































"That was one nasty explosion, it was almost like a hyrdogen bomb went off. It actually shook the houses here on Church Street."
