

Our community-based SSP's provide everything that people need...except for a reliable, safe space to use.

Over the last 30+ years, no one has died in an Overdose Prevention Site.

OPS could work with already existing programs and providers.





## What are OPS to the BRIDGES community?

OPS are indoor spaces where individuals can consume their own drugs in the presence of trained professionals (inc. people who use drugs) with immediate access to life-saving interventions, medical care, emotional support, and non-judgmental therapeutic relationships.


