The Law Department reviewed City Council Bill 2-0293 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill allows the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell its interest in the property located at 1321 Filbert Street and declares the property is no longer needed for public use. # **Position: Support**

The Department of Real Estate is reporting on CCB 22-0293 – Sale of Property – 1321 Filbert Street. The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property that is located at 1321 Filbert Street 5 (Block 7200; Lot 060A) and is no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

## **Background**

The Department of Real Estate is selling this property at the request of the Department of Public Works (DPW). The intended purchaser is Filbert Street Garden. If the ordinance is approved, the disposition will be subject to a vote by the Board of Estimates. The sale price will be \$1.00. The parcel contains the cultivation and other investments made by the Garden organization.

1321 Filbert Street property was formerly part of a larger property that is owned by the Water Utility, which includes the Curtis Bay Water Tank, part of Baltimore City's water distribution system. The Filbert Street Garden was created on a portion of the original large lot under an Adopt-A-Lot lease arrangement.

The Garden organization approached then DPW with a desire to purchase the portion they occupy. The DPW created a lot for the portion the Garden occupies through a subdivision process; gaining control of two undeveloped rights-of-way and an irregularly shaped leftover parcel belonging to the Baltimore City Public Schools (BCPS) adjacent to the Curtis Bay Water tank property to make up for the loss of the portion to be sold.

The subdivision was approved by the Planning Commission October 1, 2020. In August 2022, the DPW made a request to the Space Committee to declare 1321 Filbert Street surplus. The Space Committee assigned this parcel to the Department of Real Estate for disposal on November 4, 2022.

### The Department of Real Estate supports the passage of CCB 22-0293.

The Department of Finance is herein reporting on City Council Bill 22-0293, Sale of Property – 1321 Filbert Street, the purpose of which is to authorize the sale of 1321 Filbert Street.

### **Background**

This legislation was introduced to the City Council on behalf of the Comptroller of Baltimore City. The Department of Real Estate in the Comptroller's Office is proposing to sell this property at the request of the Department of Public Works (DPW). The intended purchaser is Filbert Street Community Garden, a 501 (c)3 non-profit organization that was founded in 2010. The Garden was established as part of the City's Adopt-A-Lot Program. The property, 1321 Filbert Street, was formerly part of a larger parcel owned by DPW, which includes the Curtis Bay Water Tank, part of Baltimore City's water distribution system.

### **Fiscal Impact**

The Department of Finance anticipates minimal fiscal impact from this legislation. If approved by City Council, the sale will be subject to a vote by the Board of Estimates and the sale price will be set at \$1.00. Since Filbert Street Community Garden currently maintains the property through the lease agreement of the Adopt-A-Lot Program, the sale of the property will not impact operating expenses.

#### Conclusion

This legislation enables the sale of 1321 Filbert Street, which the Department of Finance anticipates will have minimal fiscal impact for the City.

For the reasons stated above, the Department of Finance does not oppose City Council Bill 22-0293.
