4 5 6 7 8 9	FOR the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway to revise the boundaries of the plan to remove a certain property, to strike certain related development area controls, and to amend certain Exhibits to reflect the changes in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

15	Recitals			
16 17	The Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 88-622 and last amended by Ordinance 11-532.			
18 19 20	An amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway is necessary to revise the boundaries of the plan to remove a certain property, to strike certain related development area controls, and to amend certain Exhibits to reflect the changes in the Plan.			
21 22 23	Under Article 13, § 2-6 of the Baltimore City Code, no change may be made in any approved renewal plan unless the change is approved in the same manner as that required for the approval of a renewal plan.

1 2	<b>SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE</b> , That the following changes in the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway are approved:					
3	(1) In the Plan, strike Section I.A. in its entirety and substitute:					
4	"A. BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

6 7	The boundary description of the Plan is show outlined in red on Exhibit A, ("Boundary"), dated February 27, 2023.".					
8	(2) In the Plan, strike all references to "Development Area D-2"; and, in Section III.C.					
9 10	strike beginning with " <u>Development Area D-2</u> " down through and including "on the skyline" in its entirety.					
11	(3) Replace Exhibit A, "Boundary", dated February 9, 2011, Exhibit B, "Development					
12	Area", dated October 19, 2011, Exhibit C, "Land Use", dated February 9, 2011,					
13	Exhibit D, "Existing Zoning", dated February 9, 2011, Exhibit E, "Pedestrian					
14	Access", dated February 9, 2011, and Exhibit F "Proposed Zoning", dated					
15	October 19, 2011, with new Exhibit A, "Boundary", Exhibit B, "Development Area",					
16	Exhibit C, "Land Use", Exhibit D, "Existing Zoning", Exhibit E, "Pedestrian					
17	Access", and Exhibit F "Proposed Zoning", all dated February 27, 2023, to reflect the					
18	removal of the property known as 1302 Key Highway from the Project area.					
19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Urban Renewal Plan for Key					
20	Highway, as amended by this Ordinance and identified as "Urban Renewal Plan, Key Highway,					
21	revised to include Amendment 4, dated February 27, 2023", is approved. The Department of					
22	Planning shall file a copy of the amended Urban Renewal Plan with the Department of					
23	Legislative Reference as a permanent public record, available for public inspection and					
24	information.					
25	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if the amended Urban Renewal Plan					
26	approved by this Ordinance in any way fails to meet the statutory requirements for the content of					
27	a renewal plan or for the procedures for the preparation, adoption, and approval of a renewal					
28 29	plan, those requirements are waived and the amended Urban Renewal Plan approved by this Ordinance is exempted from them.					
30	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if any provision of this Ordinance or the					
31	application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, the					
32	invalidity does not affect any other provision or any other application of this Ordinance, and for					
33	this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.					
34	SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if a provision of this Ordinance concerns					
35	the same subject as a provision of any zoning, building, electrical, plumbing, health, fire, or					
36	safety law or regulation, the applicable provisions shall be construed to give effect to each.					
37	However, if the provisions are found to be in irreconcilable conflict, the one that establishes the					
38	higher standard for the protection of the public health and safety prevails. If a provision of this					
39	Ordinance is found to be in conflict with an existing provision of any other law or regulation that					
40	establishes a lower standard for the protection of the public health and safety, the provision of					
41	this Ordinance prevails and the other conflicting provision is repealed to the extent of the					
42	conflict.












