1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$310,000.00 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 723 (Advocacy for
3	Seniors) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2022, to
4	provide funding for Fiscal Year 2022 expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation are
5	funds from FEMA in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of
6	Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2022.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 8 enacted.
