BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the Comptroller of Baltimore City may 12 sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in 13 14 the property located at 707 East 34th Street (Block 4053, Lot 076), containing 0.95 acres, more or less, and improved by a 3 story building, previously utilized as an elementary school, 15 containing 30,036 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use. 16 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
