<u>INTRODUCTION</u> - Rezoning - 420 North Haven Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> - 420 North Haven Street For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 420 North Haven Street (Block 6265A, Lot 011) from the I-2 Zoning District, which zones for industrial zoning, to the C-3 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – City Council Bill 23-0350 seeks approval for the rezoning of 420 North Haven Street (Block 6265A, Lot 011) from the I-2 Zoning District to the C-3 Zoning District. The C-3 zoning district allows intensive commercial use including key commercial nodes that require additional controls regarding site development. This zoning category is far less restrictive for the area than previous I-2, which Planning has citied to have "no reasonable utility for industrial use". Passage will encourage further commercial development in the area.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSTION</u> – For the reasons above, The Baltimore City Department of Transportation foresee no direct operation or fiscal impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 23-0350.
