- 13 R-8 Zoning District the property known as Block 6458, Lot 004, and Block PSCO, Lot 085, as
- outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
- accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
- Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
- shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
- and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
- 20 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
- 21 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
- 22 the Zoning Administrator.
- 23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day
- 24 after the date it is enacted.
