Charter Amendment - Community Reinvestment and Reparations Fund

FOR the purpose of establishing a continuing, non-lapsing Community Reinvestment and Reparations Fund, to be used exclusively to support the work of the Community Reinvestment and Reparations Commission; authorizing the Mayor and City Council, by ordinance, to provide for the oversight, governance, and administration of this Fund; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the City for adoption or rejection.

- SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the City Charter is proposed to be amended to read as follows:

- 17 § 20. Community Reinvestment and Reparations Fund.

- 12 (B) AUTHORIZATION.
- BY ORDINANCE, THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE MAY ESTABLISH A CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUND FOR PURPOSES OF SUPPORTING THE WORK OF THE COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AND REPARATIONS COMMISSION WHICH IS TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING TO COMMUNITY-BASED INITIATIVES INTENDED TO BENEFIT LOW-INCOME COMMUNITIES DISPROPORTIONATELY HARMED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT DRUG PROHIBITION AND ENFORCEMENT POLICIES.
- 18 (C) REVENUE SOURCES.
- 19 THE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL COMPRISE:
- 29 (1) DISPURSEMENTS FROM THE STATE COMPTROLLER FROM THE STATE COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AND REPARI FUND; AND
- 31 (2) FUTURE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
 - 1 (D) CONTINUING NATURE OF FUND.
- 2 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS CHARTER, UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION:
- 4 (1) REMAIN IN THE FUND, TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THEIR ORDAINED PURPOSES;
- 5 (2) DO NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL REVENUES OF THE CITY; AND
 - 6 (3) THEIR APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.
