FOR the purpose of approving certain amendments to the Development Plan of the Stadium Place Planned Unit Development.

The Baltimore City Fire Department has no objections to City Council Bill 20-0568:Planned Unit Development-Amendment - Stadium Place. The location must comply with all applicable codes, ordinances, and laws and shall be required to obtain all required approvals. The location shall comply with the Building, Fire, and Related Codes of Baltimore City 2020 Edition (As Enacted by Ord. 15-547, and Last Amended by Ord. 18-1830) and applicable Maryland laws.

The above does not negate any requirements for submission of plans to the Office of the Fire Marshal for review of construction, Fire Detection/Notification/Suppression Systems, and Automatic Sprinkler installation. Location may be subject to an annual fire inspection and/or permits from the Office of the Fire Marshal.
