3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a change in the fees charged for certain services provided by the
4 Health Department; and providing for a special effective date.

10 **WHEREAS**, Fees charged by the City should reflect the cost of providing the service for
11 which the fee is charged.

12 **WHEREAS**, Using standardized. cost accounting methods, the City has performed a cost
13 analysis of the fees charged by the Health Department.

14 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
15 fees charged by the Health Department are changed to reflect the actual cost of the service
16 rendered, as follows:

20	Moderate Risk Food Dealer Permit	\$350	\$285
