14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Parking Tax
15 16	(\$1,947,000) and Parking Meters (\$3,053,000) in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the

21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City

24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$5,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Program 648
26	(Community Recreation Centers) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for
27	Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue
28	for this appropriation is from the Parking Tax (\$1,947,000) and Parking Meters (\$3,053,000) in

- excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
