

PARKING
OF BALTIMORE CITY
AUTHORITY

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0762, introduced by City Council member Reisinger at the request of Joseph R. Woolman, III, J.R. Woolman, and LLC.

The purpose of the Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan Key Highway to revise Exhibits C and D to reflect the change in zoning, upon approval by separate ordinance for Key Highway; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of the ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 86-622 and was last amended by Ordinance 08-50.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway and determined the amendment would have no negative impact to parking in that area. The Parking Authority would make our staff readily available to other City agencies and/or work-groups on any parking activity within this Urban Renewal Plan area.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 11-0762.
