12	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the

17	(a) In general.
18	The zoning maps, flood plain overlay maps, and flood profiles adopted under this article
19	are incorporated in and made a part of this article as fully as if they were set forth and

2 3	[As evidence of the authenticity of these maps and profiles, each is to be signed by the

12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance

14	Ordinance.

16	after the date it is enacted.
