
I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 08-0063R.

***Public Information Campaign-"Dirt Bikes"- Unregistered Motorcycles and Similar Vehicles***

For the purpose of requesting the Baltimore Police Commissioner and the Director of Transportation to develop a public information campaign to inform Baltimore City Residents which two wheeled motorized are permitted on City streets and the penalties for violating Baltimore City Code pertaining to the operation, sale, transfer and or storage of prohibited vehicles.

The Department of Transportation defers to the City Solicitor and the Baltimore City Police Department (BCPD) with regard to the interpretation of the Police Ordinances regarding Dirt Bikes and Unregistered Motorcycles and similar unregistered vehicles. Although our role regarding dirt bikes and unregistered two wheeled motor vehicles is limited to the disposal of seized vehicles, DOT would be pleased to assist the Police Department in disseminating information to the public.
