# **INTRODUCTION**

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill 21-0028, introduced by Councilmember Ramos, on January 25, 2021.

## **PURPOSE**

This Bill proposes to designate the Clifton School, located at 2670 Kennedy Avenue, as an historical landmark: exterior.

#### **BRIEF HISTORY**

The Clifton School was built in 1882 and was added to the Baltimore City Public School System in 1888, when the City of Baltimore annexed 26 square miles of Baltimore County. While many of the schools annexed in 1888 were eventually demolished and replaced, the Clifton School is a rare survivor from that period of Baltimore City's expansion.
