3 4 5 6 7	(1) [Members] EACH MEMBER of the City Council, except the President whose qualifications are provided for in Section 3, [shall] MUST be [citizens] A CITIZEN of the United States, at least 18 years old, [and] A registered [voters] VOTER of Baltimore City, AND A RESIDENT OF THE CITY FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE ELECTION AND DURING THE MEMBER'S TERM OF OFFICE.
8 9 10 11 12	(2) [They] EACH MEMBER ELECTED FROM A DISTRICT MUST also [shall] be [residents] A RESIDENT of the [districts the members have been chosen to represent] DISTRICT FROM WHICH THE MEMBER IS ELECTED for at least 1 year [next] IMMEDIATELY preceding [their] THE election, except as provided in Section 7(e), and during [their] THE MEMBER'S term of office, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 7(D).

The terms of [three] 3 appointed members [shall] expire on the last day of the year in which the term of the Mayor begins [pursuant to Article IV, Section 1], and the [four year] terms of [three] THE OTHER 3 appointed members [shall] expire [two] 2 years [thereafter] LATER.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
