**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Tax Credits – Historic Restorations and Rehabilitations**

FOR the purpose of extending the period within which applications may be accepted for the tax credit for historic restorations and rehabilitations; and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 28 - Taxes

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 28. Taxes**

**Subtitle 10. Credits**

**§ 10-8. Historic restorations and rehabilitations.**

(m) *Termination of program.*

Applications for the credit may not be accepted after February 28, [2009] 2014.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted, retroactive to February 28, 2009.
