SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the properties known as 1301, 1303, 1305, 1307, and 1309 East Lombard Street (Ward 03, Section 03, Block 1392, Lots 049, 048, 047, 046, and 045), and more particularly described as follows:

- 17The subject parcels, 1301, 1303, 1305, 1307, and 1309 East Lombard Street18(Block 1392, Lots 049, 048, 047, 046, and 045), are unimproved lots,
- 19 containing .104 acres, more or less, these properties being no longer needed for public use.
