## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 2	Zoning – Conditional Use Convalescent, Nursing, and Rest Home (Assisted Living) – 3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue
3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
4	operation of a convalescent, nursing, and rest home (assisted living) on the property known
5	as 3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a convalescent,
13	nursing, and rest home (assisted living) on the property known as 3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue, as
14 15	outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-704 and 14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:
16	1. The maximum number of resident clients is 12.
17	2. There may be no more than 2 persons per sleeping room.
18	3. 24-hour supervision must be provided.
19	4. There may be no exterior sign on the facility other than a nameplate no larger than 12
20	inches wide by 12 inches high.
21	5. The convalescent, nursing, and rest home (assisted living) complies must comply
22	with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

**EXPLANATION:** CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. Underlining indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
9 10	<b>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
