Major Issues Discussed

- 1. The representative from BBMR gave a Point Presentation. A copy is on file.
 - o Topic: FY 2026 Revenue Overview based on projections through January 31, 2025
- Committee/council members asked questions, stated concerns, and gave comments. Some highlighted topics of discussion, comments and/or concerns were:
 - o Concerns:
 - Broad-based Fees Increases
 - Any broad-based fees will hurt Baltimore City and its residents!
 - Why take it out on our residents! Some are really struggling!
 - We are just starting to see (a trend) an increase in our population
 - New fees could deter new businesses from coming here
 - If new fees and/or increases occur, businesses will definitely pass it on to the consumers, our residents!
 - How the increased rates will affect older adults is of concern!
 - o CAO Leach stated, "The City have some fees that have not been increased in years! We will be reviewing those fees, and we will be targeting certain fees. There are some services the City provides whereas the fees collected for same does not cover those services.
 - Concern: The timing of your analyses, (May vs. the Fall) why do it now instead of in the Fall?
 - I know you will be mindful and thoughtful about how increased fees are rolled out!
 - Collection of fees along with the collection rate for same
 - Talk about this
 - What are you doing to increase the collection rates?
 - What are some of your strategies for same?
 - o Income Tax Revenue
 - How will the federal workers layoffs impact our income taxes revenue?
 - Concern: City is losing residents who make under \$30,000/year this trend is of concern
 - o Traffic Cameras:
 - Where will the additional projected revenue come from?
 - Ouestions:
 - Have you thought this through when it comes to increased tipping fees for small haulers?
 - Concern: Increased illegal dumping
 - When will the final numbers be available for the revenue forecast?
- 3. CAO Leach gave closing remarks stating, "We (the City) are going to begin to face unprecedent times! Without additional revenue we will not be able to balance our budget! We will be happy to meet with councilmembers to talk about how we can obtain additional revenue and about potential cost-savings. We are concerned about reduced federal funding and reduced grant funding."
- 4. President Cohen gave closing remarks too, stating, "I hope we continue to improve our street structures and is glad to see the increased revenue in the projection for Highway Users Revenue.

I would like to see us doing everything possible to keep our residents and the upward trend in increasing the City's population.
