Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill #09-0290 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the
Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of this legislation is to Modify certain limitations on amusement
devices as necessary uses in certain zoning districts; defining certain terms; modifying
the license fee for certain amusement devices; exempting certain amusement devices
from the admissions and amusement tax; providing for an award program for persons
reporting unlicensed or unregistered amusement devices; providing for a special effective
date; and generally relating to the zoning, licensing, and taxation of amusement devices.
