A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Annual Property Tax - Fiscal Year 2011**

3 FOR the purpose of providing a tax for the use of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for
4 the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; providing for estimated billings pursuant to
5 State law; and setting the semiannual payment service charge for that period.

6 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That for
7 the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011, a tax is levied and imposed for the use of the
8 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore on all property in the City of Baltimore (except property
9 exempt by law), as follows:

10 (a) except as otherwise specified in item (b) of this section, a tax of \$2.268 is levied and
11 imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value of real property; and

12 (b) a tax of \$5.67, is levied and imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value
13 of:

14 (1) personal property; and

15 (2) operating real property described in State Tax-Property Article § 8-109(c).

16 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this tax shall be paid and collected in the
17 manner prescribed by law including the provisions of § 10-210 of the Property-Tax Article of the
18 Annotated Code of the Public General Laws of Maryland.

19 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That for the period July 1, 2010, through June
20 30, 2011, the semiannual payment service charge to be imposed under State Tax-Property Article
21 § 10-204.3 is 0.171%.

22 **SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
23 is enacted.
