Re: City Council Bill #11-0765 – Special Event Parking-Licensing and Regulation

Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill #11-0765 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of this legislation is to provide for the licensing and regulation of special event parking lots; limiting their operations to a specified Special-Event Parking District; defining certain terms; imposing certain fees; requiring payment of the parking tax; imposing certain penalties; conforming certain provisions of the Zoning and Building Codes; conforming, correcting, and clarifying other related provisions; and generally relating to the licensing, regulation, operation, and zoning of parking lots.

The Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals has reviewed this legislation and supports the passage of City Council Bill No. 11-0765.
