I am herein reporting on City Council Bill #11-0328R.

The purpose of this bill is for inviting representatives from the American Lung Association, ESP, the Department of Transportation, and the Health Department to appear before the Council to discuss trends in truck traffic through Baltimore, the implications of those trends for the health of Baltimore's citizens, and ways for the City to combat the negative health impacts of vehicle emissions.

The Department of Transportation (DOT) has many efforts in the works to protect residents from the negative effects of truck traffic, including vehicle emissions, while also enabling freight movement in the city function effectively. DOT officials will be prepared to give a thorough presentation on this issue at the hearing.
