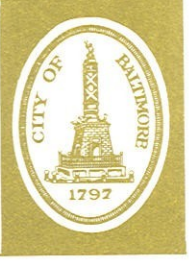

City Council Bill #08-0219 has been introduced for the purpose of providing that property tax credits applicable to the regular, citywide property tax do not apply to the Supplemental Tax imposed in the Waterfront Management District; and providing for a special effective date.

This Bill, if passed, will amend the language of the City Code concerning the Waterfront Management District by removing the word "credit" from Section 8(b)(3)(ii) so that property tax credits will not be applied to the supplemental tax bills.

Since there is no direct fiscal impact to the City, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 08-0219.
