2 3	The Board of Fire Commissioners comprises 5 members appointed by the Mayor in accordance with City Charter Article IV, \S 6.
4	(c) President.
5 6	The Mayor shall designate one member of the Board as its President in accordance with City Charter Article VII, $\S~50(B)$.
7	(d) Tenure.
8 9	The term of each member is 4 years, concurrent with the Mayor's term of office, and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
10	(E) POWERS AND DUTIES.
11 12	The Board of Fire Commissioners has the powers and duties specified in City Charter Article VII, $\S\S$ 49 to 52.
13 14 15	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
