1       **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

**Beverage Container Tax – Modifying “Sunset”**

3       FOR the purpose of accelerating the automatic termination of Ordinance 10-343 {"Beverage  
4       Container Tax"}; and generally relating to the taxation of non-reusable beverage containers.

5       By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

7                   Section 3

8       **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
9       Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Ordinance 10-342**

11       SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect  
12       on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted. This Ordinance will remain in effect  
13       [for 3 years] THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012; [at the end of] AFTER that [period] DATE,  
14       with no further action by the Mayor and City Council, this Ordinance will be  
15       abrogated and of no further effect.

16       **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
17       after the date it is enacted.
