City Council Bill #14-0353 has been introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as 1511 Ashburton Street, this property is no long needed for public use.

The subject property is the former site of the Lillian M. Jackson school building. If passed, the legislation will authorize the sale of the property via a surplus sale returning the property to the City tax rolls.

Based on the above findings, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 14-0353.
