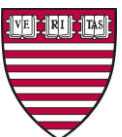

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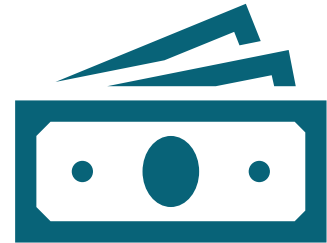

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A Story about Shelby County



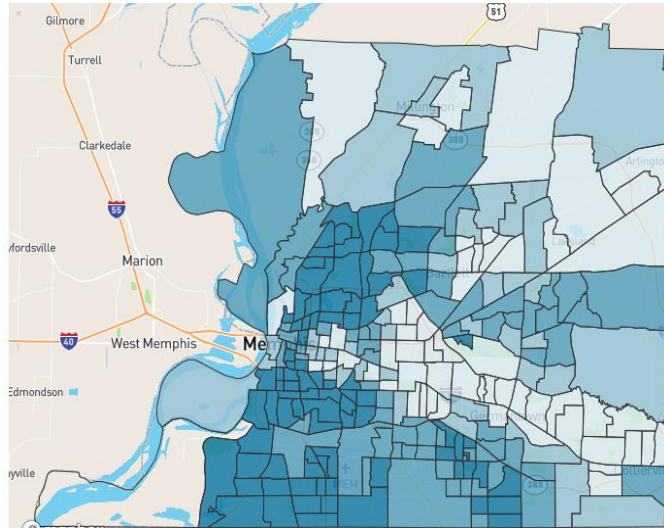
- The Shelby County Health Department has existed in some form since 1838
- Birth and death certificates were color categorized **by race** up until at least 1971



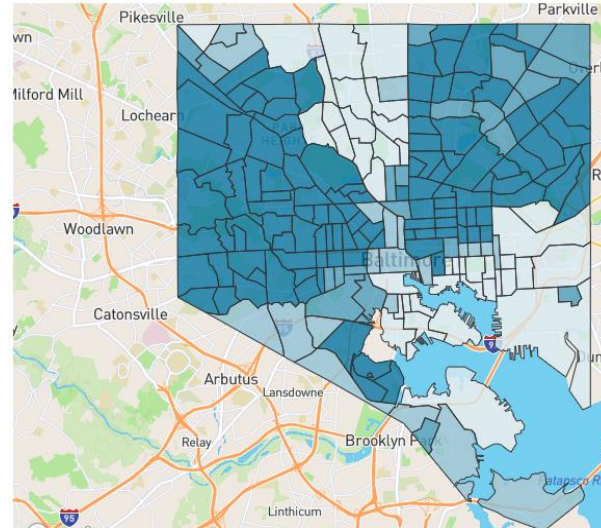
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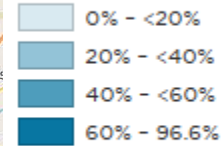
Percent Black or African American, Non-Hispanic by Census Tract, Shelby, TN, 2020



Percent Black or African American, Non-Hispanic by Census Tract, Baltimore City, 2020

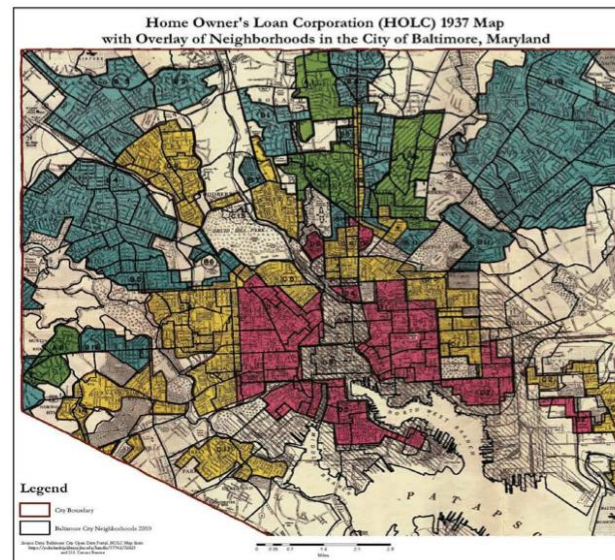
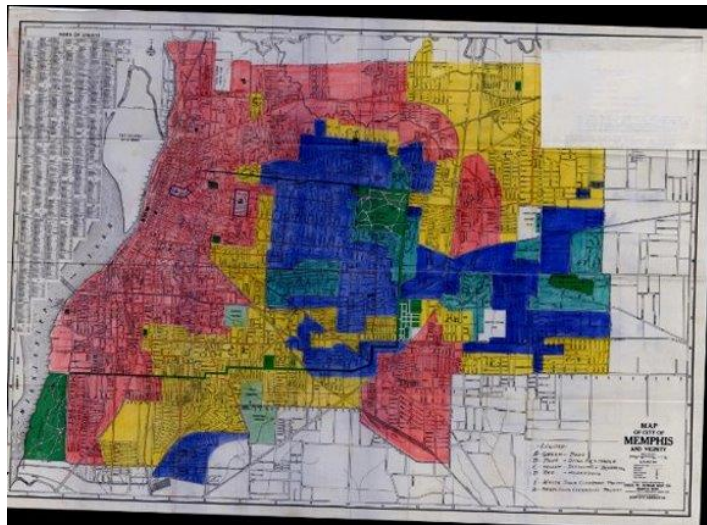


Black (Not Hispanic or Latino) per capita

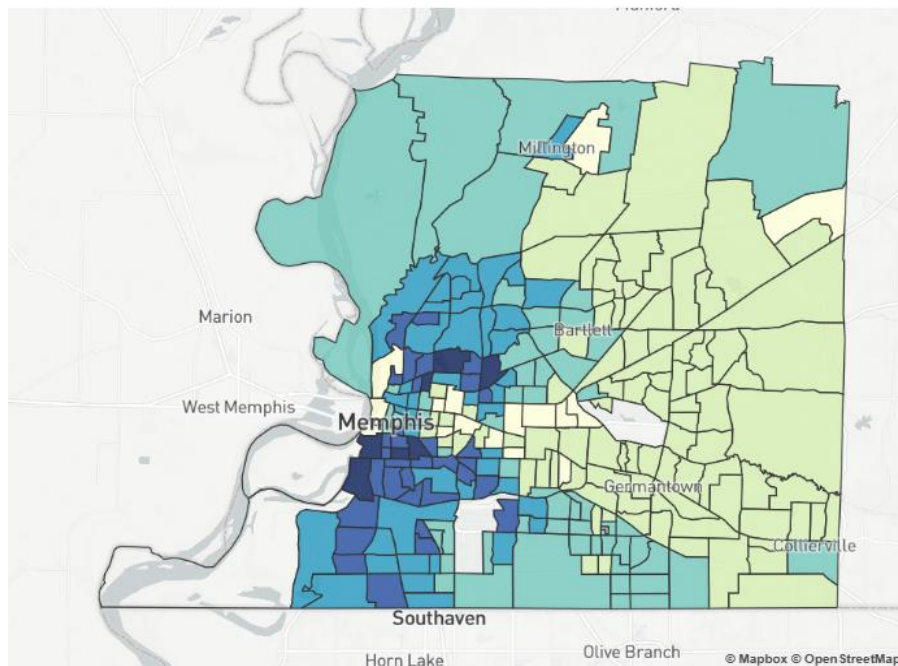


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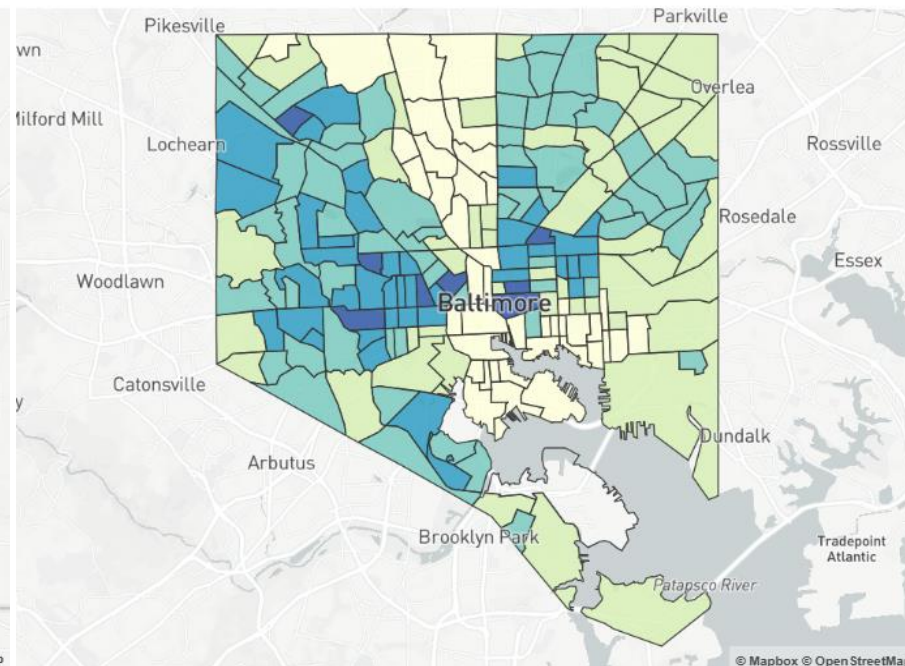
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Estimated Percent of Adults with Diabetes Diagnoses in Shelby County, TN Compared to Baltimore City, MD in 2022

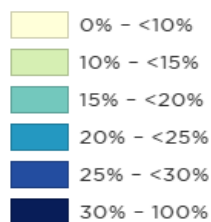
Percent of Adults with Diabetes Diagnosis by Census Tract, Shelby County, 2022

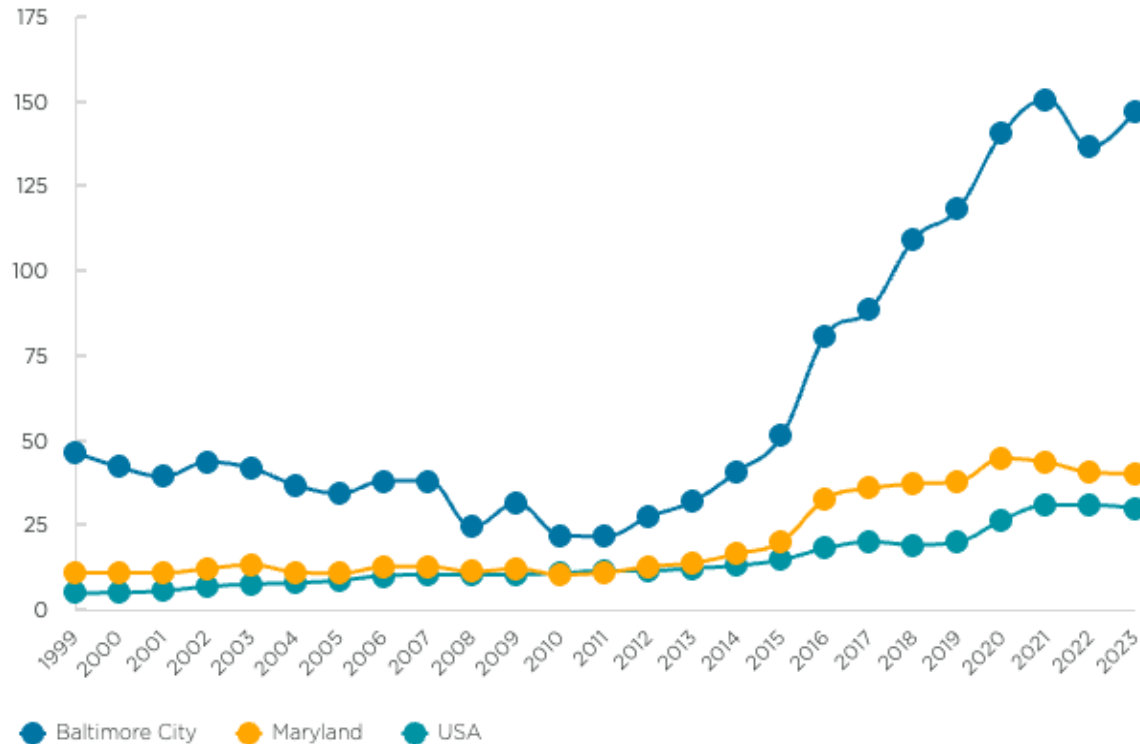

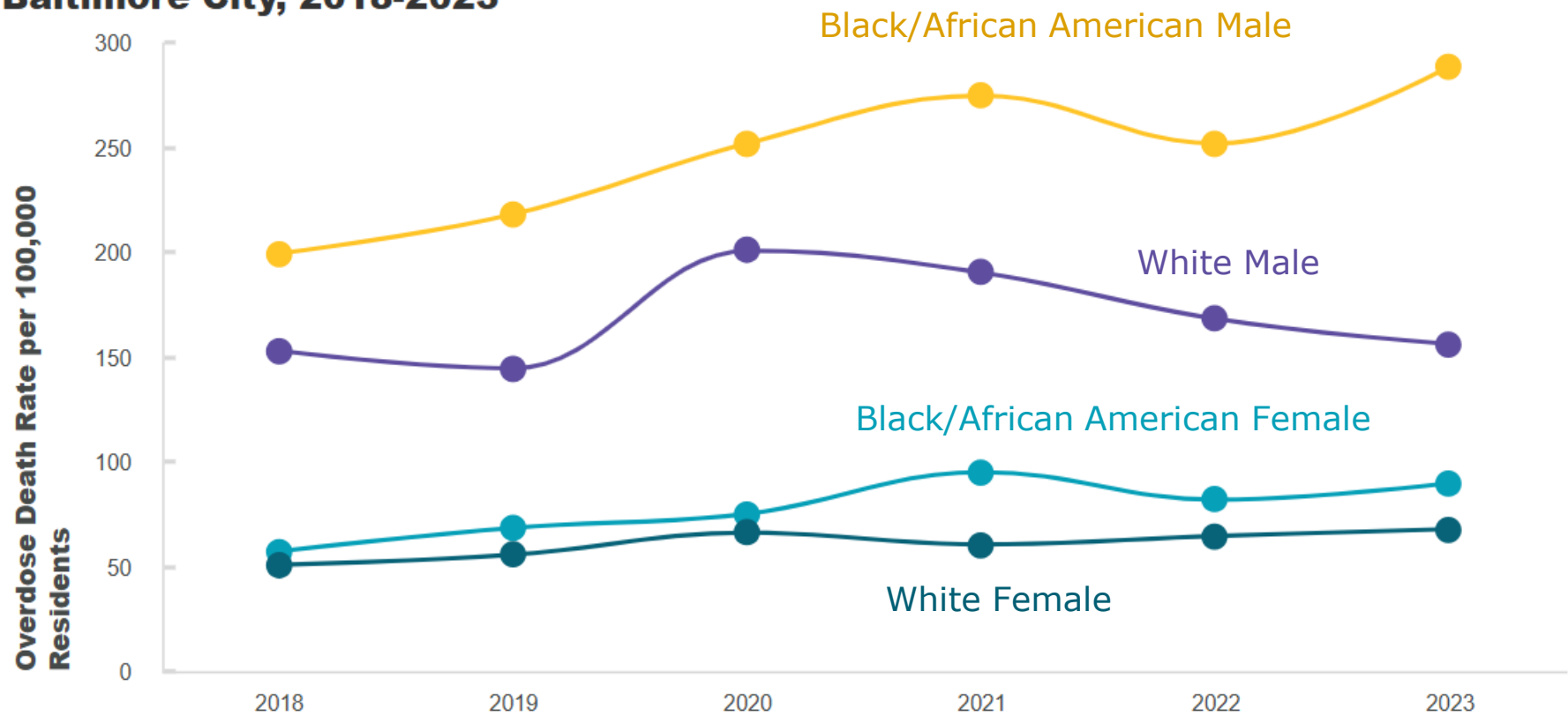


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Black/African American male residents have the highest rate of overdose death by race and sex in Baltimore City.
