13	Recitals
14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Vacant Property
15	Registration Fee (\$383,000) and Simulated Slots (\$180,000) in excess of the revenue relied on
16	by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal
17	Year 2011.
18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
19	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
22	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
23	On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
24	Council.
25	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
26	\$563,000 shall be made available to the Department of Health – Program 718 (Chronic Disease
27	Prevention) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to
28	provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation

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- is from the Vacant Property Registration Fee (\$383,000) and Simulated Slots (\$180,000) in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
