<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Rezoning - 1201 South Haven Street and a Portion of Boston Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 1201 S. Haven Street and a portion of Boston Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the I-2 Zoning District to the C-3 Zoning District; and providing for a special effective date.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 21-0119 looks to rezone 1201 South Haven Street from the I-2 Zoning District to the C-3 Zoning District. Per the City's Zoning Code, I-2 Zoning Districts allow for general industrial uses such as manufacturing, wholesale distributing, and storage. C-3 Zoning Districts allow for larger commercial and retail development, such as shopping centers. Council Bill 21-0119 was introduced in companion with Council Bill 21-0120 which seeks to amend the boundaries of the Canton Industrial Area Urban Renewal Plan.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – The parcel known as 1201 S. Haven Street is advancing towards development and currently moving through the building permit approval process. Additionally, the parcel is located with the Traffic Mitigation Zone – Southeast, Subzone C. Development within a Traffic Mitigation Zone (TMZ) has per trip fees established by DOT and approved by the Board of Estimates. The development team for this parcel is currently finalizing the Traffic Mitigation Agreement as per Ordinance 11-529. It is also worth noting that South Haven Street and Boston Street are designated "Through Truck Routes" and any modifications to the roadbed will require geometry to accommodate trucks permitted on this designed route.
