11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

15	Subtitle 37. Minors - Misappropriations and Neglect
16	§ 37-4. Child left unattended in vehicle.
17	(a) Prohibited conduct.
18	[Any] A person[, having] WHO HAS the care or custody of any child under the age of 11
19	years [who shall cause] MAY NOT CAUSE or [permit] ALLOW the child to remain in a moto
20	vehicle [while not] UNLESS THE CHILD IS attended or accompanied in that motor vehicle
21	by a RELIABLE person WHO IS at least 13 years [of age or more] OLD.
22	(b) Penalties.
23	Any person who violates this section [shall be deemed] is guilty of a misdemeanor
24	and, [upon] ON conviction, [shall be] IS subject to a fine of not more than [\$500] \$1,000
