5	requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the	
6	application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for

13	Recitals	
14 15	The Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 86-622 and last amended by Ordinance 04-829.	
16	An amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway is necessary to amend certain	
17	development area controls for Development Area A.	
18	Under Article 13, § 2-6 of the Baltimore City Code, no substantial change may be made in	
19	any approved renewal plan unless the change is approved in the same manner as that required for	
20	the approval of a renewal plan.	
21	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the	
22	following changes in the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway are approved:

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1	(1) In the Plan, amend III.C. Development Area A 4) to read as follows:		
2	Development Area A.		
3 4	4) Coverage: Building coverage on the platform and fast land areas may not exceed the following percentages of the existing aggregate of those areas:		
5	a) Grade to El. [36] 58 feet: 65%		
6	b) El. [36] 58 feet to El. 150 feet: 30%		
7	c) El. 150 feet to El. 390 feet: 16%		
8 9 10 11 12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the Urban Renewal Plan for Key Highway, as amended by this Ordinance and identified as "Urban Renewal Plan, Key Highway, revised to include Amendment 2, dated May 5, 2008", is approved. The Department of Planning shall file a copy of the amended Urban Renewal Plan with the Department of Legislative Reference as a permanent public record, available for public inspection and information.		
13 14 15 16 17	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That if the amended Urban Renewal Plan approved by this Ordinance in any way fails to meet the statutory requirements for the content of a renewal plan or for the procedures for the preparation, adoption, and approval of a renewal plan, those requirements are waived and the amended Urban Renewal Plan approved by this Ordinance is exempted from them.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That if any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, the invalidity does not affect any other provision or any other application of this Ordinance, and for this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That if a provision of this Ordinance concerns the same subject as a provision of any zoning, building, electrical, plumbing, health, fire, or safety law or regulation, the applicable provisions shall be construed to give effect to each. However, if the provisions are found to be in irreconcilable conflict, the one that establishes the higher standard for the protection of the public health and safety prevails. If a provision of this Ordinance is found to be in conflict with an existing provision of any other law or regulation that establishes a lower standard for the protection of the public health and safety, the provision of this Ordinance prevails and the other conflicting provision is repealed to the extent of the conflict.
