Re: City Council Bill 08-0130 – City Property – Naming the Clubhouse at
Forest Park Golf Course to be the Rawlings-Fulton Clubhouse

Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

You have asked the Law Department to review City Council Bill 08-0130. The bill would name the Clubhouse at Forest Park Golf Course, located near the southeast corner of Block 8393, lot 008, 120 feet north of the intersection of Forest Park Avenue and Hillsdale Road. The name of the clubhouse would be the Rawlings-Fulton Clubhouse.

The bill is consistent with Article 5, Subtitle 20 of the Baltimore City Code, which provides that “City property shall be named or renamed by an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council.”

Therefore, the Law Department would approve Council Bill 08-0130 for form and legal sufficiency.
