Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable

- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
 - V. Community Benefit

Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of March, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through March 2024, about \$232.4 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 36% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, and expenditures total \$232,393,085 through March 2024.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of March 2024, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$26.4 million. See Table 1 for total disbursements. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in March are as follows:

- Baltimore Corps established career advancement events to provide information and recruitment for the Community Health Pathways (CHP), and AmeriCorps program. These events were designed to foster learning and provide accessible avenues for professional growth.
- Leadenhall Baptist Church held their Pantry on the Go on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 from 10 a.m.-12 Noon to distribute fresh produce, canned goods, dry goods and poultry. Leadenhall Baptist Church is scheduled to have another Pantry on the Go on Tuesday, June 18, 2024.
- Wide Angle's winter middle school trimester program successfully launched and ran from January-March. Three school sites participated: Mt. Royal Elementary/Middle School, Calvin M. Rodwell Elementary/Middle School, and Baltimore Design School, cumulatively engaging 42 youth in grades 6-8 in introductory media education activities. Wide Angle's high school programs are also underway, including a full semester of programming with 5 classes offered at Wide Angle's headquarters with 48 9th-12th graders participating.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

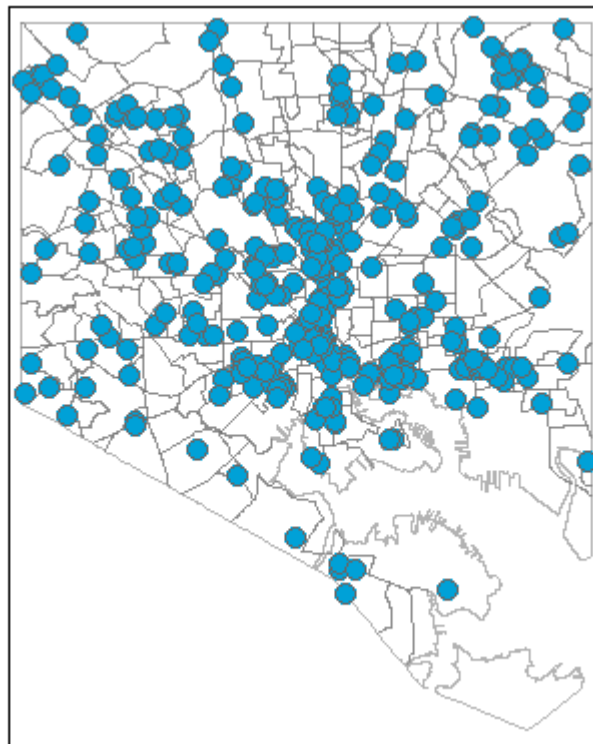
Subawardee Accomplishments

Economic Recovery Fund

There have been 1,067 grants awarded, totaling \$19,777,345, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a

complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through March 2024. Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance

BDC processed a limited number of first and second round checks – totaling 18 checks (7 second checks to Round 1 awardees and 11 second checks to Round 2 awardees). BDC continues to coordinate with businesses in Round 2 to gather and authenticate the necessary documentation to issue checks. BDC is also coordinating with businesses on eligible uses of grant funding, as some businesses' needs have changed since submitting their application for funding. BDC is also in the process of coordinating with the Recovery Office to review expenditures, budgets, and performance of the Technical Assistance partners in the BASE Network.

City Agencies Accomplishments

Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)

After evaluating submitted bids, BCRP awarded the construction contract for Gardenville Recreation Center to the Board of Estimates on March 6, 2024. BCRP also received bids for Towanda and Coldstream Pool Renovations (which were packaged into one solicitation) on March 6, 2024, which are currently under review and being processing for award.

Sixteen of seventeen playground projects have scheduled construction dates between April and June 2024. The final playground requires a contract upset limit increase which is in process. BCRP is also working with the Bureau of Procurement to increase the upset limit for the resurfacing contract that will allow the completion of the remaining two athletic court resurfacing projects this year.

Bids are due for the Gwynns Falls Trail signage solicitation on May 1, 2024.

Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)

Vulnerable Communities/Adult Guardianship

There are currently three case managers staffed in the program through ARPA. Two case manager candidates have been identified and accepted offers, with anticipated start dates in May. BCHD is currently recruiting for the social worker position.

Food insecurity

Highlights of this project are as follows:

- **SNAP Outreach:** BCHD's Baltimore Corps Fellows are working closely with Maryland Food Bank and the Department of Planning (DOP) to provide SNAP outreach and assistance. The Fellows attend senior centers with the Maryland Food Bank to help center members apply for SNAP and provide clarity around benefits. Additionally, BCHD works closely with DOP to specifically target older adults to participate in the B'more Fresh program. Fellows help older adults navigate the platforms and make online grocery purchases. BCHD plans to continue with additional outreach efforts in the coming months at senior centers. With the recent bill passed by the state regarding SNAP minimums for older adults (lowering the age from 62 to 60 and increasing the minimum benefit from \$40 to \$50), the team hopes that this will allow BCHD to engage more older adults to consider signing up for SNAP.
- **Meals and Food Boxes:** Meals continue to have high participation. BCHD and its partners serve over 1,000 households with home-delivered meals, over 1,000 households through the congregate meal program, and over 1,000 households with the home-delivered Food Box program.
- **City of Refuge:** The City of Refuge provides meals and a food pantry for residents in the Brooklyn and Curtis Bay communities. They have served over 950 households through the pantry and 4,500 meals to the community. The organization continues to provide culturally appropriate food resources to the Spanish-speaking community and have been providing meals to the Comiendo Juntos program located in Assisi House in East Baltimore where Spanish-speaking older adults have been able to connect and establish community with one another.

Vaccination

BCHD partners held 35 clinics with 315 doses administered in March.

Thirty (30) VALUE communities' engagement events were held in the month of March to

promote COVID-19 vaccination. These engagement efforts occurred at various community events including at schools, senior centers, food distribution sites, and health/resource fairs. Another 20 VALUE communities' events have been scheduled for the month of April.

Baltimore City Information & Technology (BCIT)

Hardware Refresh, CitiWwatch, and Hybrid Meeting Rooms

The full CitiWatch infrastructure budget has been encumbered. Five meeting rooms were successfully outfitted into hybrid meeting rooms last month.

Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)

Public Wi-Fi Initiative

Baltimore's public Wi-Fi initiative, FreeBMoreWiFi, was successfully launched at Bentalou Recreation Center (March 19), Medfield Park Recreation Center (March 13), and Madison Square Recreation Center (March 26).

Chromebook Distribution

Through this program 3,453 Chromebooks were distributed in March, bringing the total distribution to 17,179 as of April 11, 2024. The distribution partners include Thread, Maryland Family Network, the Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC), Enterprise Community Development, and Project Waves.

Employee Digital Skills

The digital skills program for City employees has a total enrollment of 120 and total attendance of 82 employees. Fifteen employees enrolled in April's session, demonstrating continued interest and commitment to upskilling.

Community Meetings

The BDE office hosts meetings led by Digital Equity Coordinator to provide a platform for information sharing and collaboration within the community. A total of two community meetings were hosted in the month of March representing various partners and community members. The meetings included discussions and a general update on the progress of ongoing initiatives. The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) Information Community Meeting was hosted on March 28th. This meeting covered the latest updates from Congress, the Federal Communications Commission and the State of Maryland on the future of the ACP along with plans from Internet Service Providers (ISPs) for customers transitioning out of ACP.

Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

MOHS has made significant advancements in implementing ARPA funded programs, including the 2 hotel acquisitions, the implementation of the Flex and Landlord Incentive Fund Program, the Housing Navigation project in collaboration with Enoch Pratt Library, the Housing Accelerator Fund awards and the Supportive Housing Institute. In the month of March, a press event was held to announce the recipients of Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF) capital awards. Nine projects received HAF funding totaling \$15,186,000. These projects include a total of 120 units (87 new) of Permanent Supportive Housing and an additional 257 units of affordable housing. Six of the projects awarded are led by emerging, Black and other persons of color, and/or women. Also, in the month of March, two training and project planning sessions were conducted as part of the Baltimore Supportive Housing Institute. This included a virtual session on best practices in project design, as well as two days of in person sessions focused on budgeting for capital, operating, and services. Participants from 11 organizations participated in the sessions as well as local DHCD and Maryland DHCD staff.

MOHS has updated its website that includes an annual report and has published its first monthly newsletter highlighting ARPA Initiatives. In addition, the newsletter provides current updates and information for stakeholders. MOHS continues to actively engage the community through the direct work with Landlord Engagement and Rapid Rehousing programs. Monthly outreach to the Providers, and the Coordinated Access staff has been positive in collaboration with United Way and Housing Navigators to ensure that the Flex Fund is being used to reduce evictions and rapidly resolve homelessness. MOHS works closely with the Continuum of Care and is currently in the process of engaging advocates and the community to participate in the development of Permanent Supportive Housing standards.

Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

Victim Services

MONSE hosted a successful and well-attended Human Trafficking information session for the Brooklyn community at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church. With 26 attendees and multiple vendors on hand, the event helped raised awareness while also providing educational material and resources to Brooklyn residents.

Finance

The following ARPA-funded programs received Board of Estimates approval in March: University of Maryland Medical System – Hospital-based Violence Intervention Program contract - \$250,000; Fayette Street Outreach (Neighborhood Policing Plan contract) - \$344,654.

Community Violence Intervention (CVI)

Throughout the month of March, MONSE saw significant progress in hiring and promotions across several Safe Streets Baltimore (SSB) locations, including:

- Three new staff were hired at Sandtown Winchester
- Two new staff were hired at Penn North
- An offer was extended to fill the Violence Prevention Coordinator vacancy at Woodbourne-McCabe)
- A modified plan in Belair-Edison allowed MONSE to reopen the site with amended staffing.

Temporary staffing include MONSE CVI liaisons and LifeBridge CVI managers. Planning is also currently underway for the fourth annual Safe Summer program, which promises a season packed with movie nights, pool parties, block parties, resource fairs and more. Last year saw 42 events hosted across all ten sites, and MONSE hopes to exceed those figures in 2024. MONSE is also making preparations for "Safe Streets: The Movement", a public rally designed to spread the message and work of Safe Streets, in locales where engagement is particularly low. The rally will seek to connect with and engage high-risk individuals who may be unfamiliar with the work of Safe Streets, or who may have been reluctant to participate in past outreach efforts.

Group Violence Reduction Strategy

Following successful implementation of GVRS into the Central District earlier this year, preparations are now underway (and nearly complete) for next-stage expansion into the Eastern district. Expansion into the Eastern District comes as the City continues to see a reduction in homicides and non-fatal shootings, notably in districts where GVRS is in place. As of March 31st, there have been 16 homicides and 34 non-fatal shootings across the Western, Southwestern, and Central Districts, down from 20 homicides and 44 non-fatal shootings in 2023. In addition, MONSE recently finalized and activated its MOU with the Mayor's Office of

Employment and Development (MOED) to bolster transitional employment support for GVRs, Returning Citizens Behind the Wall (RCBTW), and other CVI-related participants.

Following program expansion into the Eastern District, the MONSE GVRs Deputy Director delivered a townhall-style presentation of GVRs to highlight the program's mission, impact, and potential for residents following expansion into the Eastern. This presentation was a key feature of BPD's most recent Community Relations Council (CRC) meeting in the district.

MONSE will also continue to facilitate its weekly coordination meeting with community moral voices, while continuing to attend and participate in multiple community meetings throughout the city.

Community Safety and Response

MONSE has been coordinating with BPD in specific target enforcement zones, mobilizing Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) resources for day-long outreach intensives. This approach is intended to ensure maximum outreach and impact potential, combining elements of a traditional resource fair with on-the-ground canvassing and community engagement. With its proactive approach, MONSE and BPD are working to uplift areas with a history of CNSR engagement. Similarly, CNSR staff were on hand for a community prayer walk in the York Road/Woodbourne Avenue neighborhood, facilitating a day of outreach and engagement (in partnership with BPD and local leadership).

In order to better ensure the safety of CNSR personnel during outreach in community, MONSE and BPD recently installed new operational procedures that will improve cross-communication and security, while also establishing best practices to limit risk for personnel.

Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)

Baltimore New American Access Coalition (BNAAC)

BNAAC projects to enroll 695 cases in overall, comprised of 65 individual cases and 635 family cases. Global Refuge provided four trainings this month consisting of two employment resource trainings, and one-on-one database training.

In the past month BNAAC outreach has occurred at a resource fair in Morrel Park and at Baybrook EMS, a presentation at a family meeting at Charles Carol Barrister, tabling at a Curtis Bay and Park Heights food distribution events, tabling at a community fair at Lakeland Recreation and STEAM Center. In the next month BNAAC outreach will include tabling at BenFest a community fair at Benjamin Franklin Highschool, a community resource fair at Fallstaff EMS, Dia del Nino at Patterson Park, a BNAAC co-sponsored Resource Fair in Brooklyn as well as family BNAAC presentations at St. Vincent DePaul HeadStart and Curtis Bay and Cherry Hill Judy Centers.

Language Access

MIMA conducted briefing sessions with agency directors on the CAO's language access directive and policy. This has helped establish a foundation for moving forward with collaboration to create language access guidance documents.

MIMA presented at the Latino Provider Network's monthly meeting on March 25th to share about MIMA's language access work with community organizations and providers throughout the City of Baltimore. MIMA is preparing to present at the Baltimore Immigration Summit in May and will host its next Language Access Oversight Committee meeting on later that same month.

Finally, on March 25th, the new ARPA Language Access Project Manager was onboarded to the MIMA team.

Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)

DHCD – Permitting System Upgrades

DHCD has reported significant progress in the implementation of the permitting system upgrades including:

- Data conversion Schema Development
- License Registration Report Development
- Multiple configuration updates from action items

DHCD – Impact Investment Areas

During last reporting period a total of 22 acquired properties went to the BOE for approval of purchase. The properties represent approximately \$615,000 in expenditures for the IANRF project.

Department of General Services (DGS)

Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet

DGS has received 50 of the BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 50 BPD PIUs are estimated to be delivered in mid-2024. The 50 vehicles received to-date have all been upfitted and 28 are now in service.

Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers

DGS fleet has received nine (9) ARPA-funded load packers. These units have been upfitted, tagged, and labeled and are now in service.

HVAC Improvements at City Libraries

DGS and Rife International have finalized the overall design-build cost for the six (6) libraries that are part of the Enoch Pratt Free HVAC Repair Project. The contract was approved on the March 6th BOE meeting and the notice to proceed was issued for April 17, 2024.

Capital Improvements

The pre-construction meeting for the Northwest Community Action Center project was held on March 26, 2024. The notice to proceed was issued for April 15, 2024. In the next 1-2 months DGS, will be placing signage at the Northwest Community Action Center that will inform the building users and visitors about the ongoing roof and storefront replacement project.

The City Hall Roof project was advertised for bid on January 26, 2024, and all bids were received by March 6, 2024, and are currently under review.

In March, two interagency agreements were executed with DGS for \$5.3M to carry out facilities improvements at Baltimore City Fire Stations. These include roof replacements, bathroom renovations, and other facility upgrades. DGS is currently amending and procuring contracts to carry out these improvements.

Department of Public Works (DPW)

Waste Removal

DPW is utilizing \$3,285,000 in ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year to help return to weekly recycling services. The contract will end October 31, 2024.

Recycling Crews

All thirty (30) ARPA funded recycling crew positions (10 solid waste drivers and 20 solid waste workers) have been hired. These roles experience elevated turnover rates across the industry, a trend that similarly impacts DPW. DPW's solid waste team and HR department are actively engaged in efforts to promptly fill any positions that become open.

Capital and Operating Improvements

DPW will utilize \$5,659,780 in ARPA funds for capital and operating improvements. Capital improvements include facility upgrades at various locations. Operating improvements include the purchase of new technology such as routing software and tablets, as well as larger equipment including mini-load packers, tractors, and bobcats. DPW is currently working to amend existing contracts to include specific ARPA language.

Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)

Seventeen Train Up Occupational Skills training providers continue to provide services, including 7 funded by City ARPA. All Support Services and Community Connectors contracts are also in place and services continue – these agreements will be extended into 2025. In total (including City and State funding) Train Up has enrolled 1136 residents in training, of whom 519 are with City ARPA-funded programs. So far, 495 have earned one or more industry-recognized credential. While a total of 649 enrollees have completed training, many are still in training, working towards their certifications, and receiving job matching services. MOED has logged 327 of the reported job placements, with additional job placements reported and logged monthly. The average wage to date is \$19.06/hour well above the target of \$15.00/hour and minimum wage. To date, at least 569 participants have taken advantage of free legal services. 546 participants have received group or individual behavioral health services.

Three hundred and seventeen unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment through Hire Up, with 204 who were funded by City ARPA. In total, 131 of those who remained in the program at least two weeks have transitioned to unsubsidized employment, 121 of whom reported an entry wage of \$16/hour or higher. MOED will meet the performance target of 330 hired into subsidized positions in April.

The Wage Subsidy to Small, Minority- and/or Woman-Owned Businesses was very successful. In total, just over \$2.7M of MOED's ARPA funds were invested to support COVID recovery for 188 Small, Minority and Women Owned Businesses. 460 un- and under-employed Baltimore residents impacted by COVID were hired because of this investment. Based on survey results, beneficiary employers reported 10-week retention rates of 96% and 6-month retention rate of 80% with an average wage of \$21.53. 70% of the beneficiary businesses stated that they reinvested the subsidy to raise salaries and hire more people.

The Let's Ride to Work program has resumed utilizing second phase State ARPA funds. MOED is working to add additional funding via City ARPA to serve an additional 315 residents. Through the end of this reporting period, 556 newly employed Baltimore residents have taken advantage of 18,057 free rides through this program. 94% of post-survey respondents have rated the program as "Very Helpful" and 87% or 46 of 53 survey respondents reported still working at the time they completed the survey.

Youthworks wages for Program Year 2023 (fiscal year 2024) have been booked to ARPA – funding 1840 slots for youth workers. Additionally, MOED piloted the year-round internship program in fall of 2023 and exceeded the mayor's original request of employing 100 youth by

more than double and launched the program with 218 youth and 46 youth employers in the Fall Session. The design of the program is for all those that participated in the Fall do so in the Spring. However, some youth opted out due to school obligations and scheduling. Still, 166 youth are participating in the second session.

A snapshot of recent and/or upcoming events is provided below. MOED is involved in community engagement efforts on a weekly basis.

- High School Job Fair at War Memorial – March 20, 2024
- Monthly Hiring Fair partnership with Safe Streets – April 9, 2024
- East Side Career Hiring Event - April 3, 2024
- Youth Apprenticeship Week – May 6-10, 2024

Baltimore City Fire Department (BCFD)

In March, an agreement was signed with BCFD for \$4.7 million in ARPA funding for the strategic acquisitions of life-saving equipment, reinforcing safety standards for our firefighters, emergency medical services personnel, and the broader Baltimore community. The equipment includes self-contained breathing apparatuses, thermal imaging cameras, hose replacements, and rain hoods. In addition to the two capital projects for BCFD being overseen by DGS, the total amount awarded benefiting BCFD in March totals \$10M.

Performance Measures and Metrics

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available. Population, Labor & Employment Growth
