1. Councilmember Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and read the bill into the record.
2. Councilmember Conway commented about the purpose of the bill. He emphasized that discussions were held with residents, businesses and the nearby school representatives regarding changes to the residential parking permit program. He also explained how the proposed changes impact sign postings and enforcement, including time limits for parking on each side of the street.
3. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies.
4. Victor Tervala offered a technical amendment for the bill.
5. The committee opened the hearing for public testimony.
6. The committee approved the Law Department’s amendment for the bill.
7. The committee approved a motion to recommend the bill favorably with an amendment.
