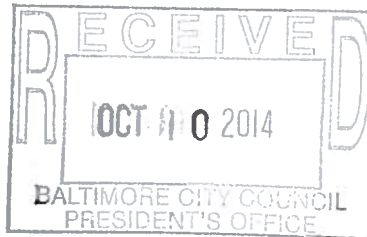

For the purpose of granting a franchise to Morgan State University to construct, use and maintain (1) a private pedestrian bridgeway above and across the 4100 block of Hillen Road right-of-way and (2) the bridgeway foundation and supporting columns in and below the Hillen Road right-of-way, subject to certain terms, conditions, and reservations; and providing for a special effective date.

The Fire Department has no objection to City Council Bill # 14-0427 as proposed provided that all applicable fire and life safety codes are adhered to. Also, it needs to be assured that the pedestrian bridge provides sufficient clearance for vehicles of extra height to navigate under ; in particular, emergency apparatus.
