

Dear Council President Young and Chairman Costello,

Thank you for meeting with me and our CFO John Walker this morning. We are very grateful for the City Council's public commitment on March 20, 2017, of an additional \$10 million in funding for City Schools. We are also appreciative of the unprecedented commitment this year to City Schools from the General Assembly and Mayor Pugh's Administration.

As discussed this morning, if the City Council is able to reach agreement with the Mayor on the \$10 million in funding, it is my belief that the additional funds should be expended in a fiscally responsible manner, similar to the existing three-year commitment from the state and city.

I would propose that approximately \$1 million be expended on currently proposed cuts to community schools for 2017-18. As the Council is aware, community schools serve extremely vulnerable student populations and cutting these services so close to the 2017-18 school year would have dire consequences.

I would further propose that the remaining \$9 million be expended evenly over the following three school years, starting in 2017-18. The most effective use of this funding would be a split amongst the following three areas:

- Leadership training for our principals and assistant principals—This funding would expand leadership development opportunities for our principals and assistant principals and will allow City Schools the opportunity to build a leadership pipeline.
- 2) Middle grades initiative—Additional funds would allow the district to deepen our support for early adolescents throughout the district. This would include expansion of peer leadership opportunities, more rigorous and enriched learning opportunities, and expanded support for our most vulnerable middle school readers.
- 3) Community Schools Other Than Personnel Services (OTPS)—City Schools can build the capacity of parents, families and community to better support student learning and well-being beyond the classroom through trainings focused on comprehensive literacy strategies to equip parents with skills to partner in their children's education and building community through advocacy and decision making.

Thank you again for your leadership and continued commitment to the education and development of our city's student-scholars.

Further appropriations for programs included in the proposed Ordinance of Estimates made necessary by a material change in circumstances, or additional appropriations for new programs which could not reasonably be anticipated at the time of the formulation of the proposed Ordinance of Estimates may be made available to the appropriate municipal agency for expenditure by a supplementary appropriation ordinance recommended to the City Council by the Board of Estimates, duly passed by the City Council by a vote of three-fourths of its members and approved by the Mayor.

(c) Supplementary appropriations - Requisites of ordinance.

Every such further or additional appropriation shall be embodied in a separate ordinance limited to a single program, purpose, activity or project therein stated, and each such supplementary appropriation ordinance shall also, anything contained in the Charter to the contrary notwithstanding, provide the revenue necessary to pay the appropriation by a source, other than the full rate property tax, imposed under the authority of Article II. 


