INTRODUCTION – City Streets - Closing - Air Rights over a Portion of the Public Right of Way of Rogers Alley

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of condemning and closing the air rights area over a portion of the public right of way of Rogers Alley, as shown on Plat 313-A-23A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.
