FOR the purpose of appointing the Inspector General to serve as the Executive Director of the Board of Ethics; requiring that the Office of the Inspector General provide staff to the Board of Ethics; and providing for a special effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Subtitle 3. Administration

PART II. STAFF AND OTHER ASSISTANCE

§ 3-11. Executive Director and staff.

(a) *Director.*

The [Director of Legislative Reference] INSPECTOR GENERAL serves as the Executive Director of the Ethics Board and is responsible for assisting the Board in performing its responsibilities.

2 In consultation with the Board, the Executive Director may assign staff from the
3 [Department of Legislative Reference] OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL to assist the
4 Board and Executive Director.

5 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
6 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
7 Ordinance.

8 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 180th
9 day after the date it is enacted.
