The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0696, an ordinance for the purpose of rezoning several residential properties known as 811, 821, 825, 831 and 933 W. Fayette Street from R-9 Zoning District to B 2-3 Zoning District. Rezoning of these properties will allow the University of Maryland, Baltimore BioPark to expand the footprint of the proposed Proton Cancer Center from Baltimore Street to Fayette Street.
