The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill No. 08-0255- Taxicabs and other Common Carriers-Refusal to Pay Fare which clarifies language in Article 19 § 52 and provides increased penalties for failure to pay the fare for transportation in a taxicab or other vehicle operated as a common carrier.

The BPD supports these changes as increased penalties for violating this provision will provide deterrent value for committing this type of offense. Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this legislation.
