I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0280.

City Streets - Closing – A 15-Foot Alley.

For the purpose of condemning and closing a 15-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as Nos. 2501/2507 through 2511/2517 Eutaw Place, extending from Chauncey Avenue, Northwesterly 108.0 feet, more or less, to the southeast side of a 15-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as Nos. 914 through 934 Chauncey Avenue, as shown on Plat 316-C-1 in the Office of the Department of Public Works; and providing for a special effective date.

The bill, if passed, would close a portion of a 15-foot alley in the rear of Beth Am Synagogue. The Congregation owns two row houses that bound the alley directly behind the Synagogue. It is their intention to raze the row houses and build multi-purpose space connected to the main building. DPW has approved the plan and will move its utilities and the Planning Department has approved the closing.

In that DPW and the Planning Department have approved the closing, the Department of Transportation has no objection to the passage of this bill.
