Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill No. 19-0390 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of City Council Bill No. 19-0390 is to change the zoning for the property known as 1617 Broening Highway (Block 6810, Lot 001) from the C-4 Zoning District to the C-3 Zoning District.

The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and <u>defers to the Planning Department's report and recommendation</u>. BMZA is generally not in favor of single-property rezoning unless a broader public benefit can be identified in conjunction with compliance with the requisite legal standards.
