11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
12 name of the location of the entrance of the Maryland Zoo in Baltimore is changed from
13 Beechwood Drive in Druid Hill Park to One Safari Place.

14 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
15 after the date it is enacted.
