Re: **City Council Bill 13-0188 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Brinks Building**

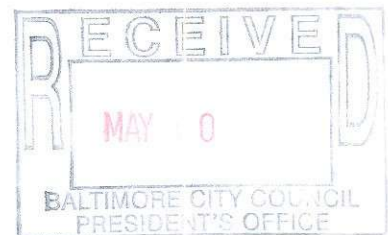
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0188, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Brinks Building, 231 North Holliday Street, as a historical landmark.

This bill, if enacted, would add the property known as 231 North Holliday Street—the Brinks Building—to the Baltimore City Landmark List. The subject property is located in the Downtown neighborhood and within the Central Business District Urban Renewal Plan.
