The Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) is pleased to have the opportunity to review Council Bill 14-0417- Corrective Bill 2014. The purpose of this bill is to correct certain technical errors and omissions in the City Code; repeal certain obsolete, obsolescent or otherwise preempted, superseded, or superfluous provisions; correct, clarify and conform certain language; and provide for a special effective date.

BCHD supports changing Title 12, Subtitle 7 of the Health Code from "Mobile Vendors" to "Smoking in Vendor Trucks" because this language better reflects the scope of the provision. Smoking is prohibited on any vendor truck. BCHD also supports removing the superfluous language and correcting punctuation in Title 12, Subtitle 8 – Smoking Near Playgrounds of the Health Code. BCHD has no opposition to these corrections.
