17	(A) AUTHORIZATION.
18	(1) By Ordinance, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore may establish 1
19	OR MORE CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUNDS FOR PURPOSES OF ENHANCING THE
20	EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT IN BALTIMORE CITY BY CREATING MODERN, STATE-OF-
21	THE-ART SCHOOLS.
22	(2) These purposes include supporting and augmenting programs and activities

16	(2) do not revert to the general revenues of the City; and
17	(3) THEIR APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
